## ***Group Headquarters***

As you may have noticed we are still in the middle of a building site! In case you are not aware the developers of the Parkgate site are building us a garage plus a new entrance to the front of the building which will have ramp access and also include wheelchair accessible toilet facilities.

We did expect these two pieces of work to be largely complete by now. We are doing our best to *encourage* the developers to get this work completed as soon as possible as it is causing us a number of difficulties. In the meantime thank you for your cooperation during this period.

While the development is still going on please be **extra careful** around the site.

The group executive has just completed a risk assessment of the car parking area which we will be presenting to the developers. We have highlighted the inadequate lighting now that all sections will be arriving and departing in the dark and will ask for extra signage to get all drivers to slow down coming into the car park.

Take extra care when leaving the building via the temporary exit. Vehicles accessing the legion pass very close to this door. **Do not run out of that exit!**

Please take extra care when driving in and out of the car park. In particular take it very slowly. It is currently very crowded with both First Shirley and the Legion using the car park. Once the new Asda car park is open, First Shirley will have exclusive use of the car parking in front of our building during the evenings when meetings take place.

## ***Headquarters Refurbishment***

The group and the developers have just signed the documents which put into place our new 60 year lease and also completed the agreement we have with the developers regarding the building work and refurbishment of the HQ. This has been a very long process (in excess of 10 years !!) for which I would like to thank the Group Executive who have worked tirelessly to get this to a conclusion.

The immediate effect of signing this agreement is that we have received, upon signing the new lease, a large sum of money to carry out much needed refurbishments and updates to the building.

We have a broad plan of what should be done. Now it needs to be finalized and then implemented. We want to do this (and more importantly **should** do this) with involvement from members of the group.
